The homes are all energy poor and in substantial need of retrofit work. The measures include high efficiency condensing boilers with zoned heating controls, attic and wall insulation and CFLs.</p> <p>Total Project: €112,665 Grant Approved: €73,232</p>
Drishane View, Millstreet, Co. Cork	<p>Moderate energy upgrades will be installed in 14 mixed ownership homes in Mill Street Co. Cork. 86% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, cavity wall insulation and high efficiency boiler complete with heating controls. IRD Duhallow Ltd., Cork County Council and Enprova are the partners on this project</p> <p>Total Project: €103,934.08 Grant Approved: €70,425.73</p>

<p>South Dublin County Council</p>	<p>Moderate and deep energy upgrades will be installed in 75 homes and one community house in Tallaght, Dublin 24. 80% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, cavity insulation, window upgrades, CFLs and high efficiency gas condensing boilers with full heating controls package. The measures include attic insulation, cavity wall insulation, high efficiency oil and gas boiler with zoned heating controls, chimney draught Limiters, CFLs and window and door upgrades. <p>Cherry Orchard, Ballyfermot, Dublin 10</p>	<p>Deep upgrades to 77 housing association homes in Cherry Orchard, Ballyfermot, Dublin 10. 75% of the homes are energy poor. This project represents an opportunity to trial a form of Pay as You Save energy retrofit financing. The measures include high efficiency gas boilers, remote access heating controls, loft and cavity wall insulation, CFLs and windows and doors. <p>Barry's Place, Newmarket, Co. Cork</p>	<p>Moderate upgrades to 19 mixed ownership homes in Barry's Place, Newmarket, Co. Cork. 74% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, cavity wall insulation, high efficiency boiler replacement, CFLs and chimney draught limiters. IRD Duhallow, Cork County Council and Retrofit Energy Ireland are the partners in this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 61,701.00 Grant Approved: € 47,645.00</p>
<p>Sliabh Luachra, Gneeveguilla, Co. Kerry</p>	<p>Moderate depth upgrades to 13 mixed ownership homes in Sliabh Luachara, Gneevegiolla, Co. Kerry. 69% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include roof, dry-lining, cavity wall insulation, high efficiency boiler with heating controls, chimney draught limiter and CFLs. IRD Duhallow Ltd, Kerry County Council and Retrofit Energy Ireland are the partners in this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 31,834.00 Grant Approved: € 22,631.00</p>
<p>Better Energy Warmer Homes, Area Scheme in County Limerick</p>	<p>Shallow upgrades of 214 local authority homes in various estates in County Limerick. 63% of the homes are energy poor. <p>Southill Development Co-op Ltd</p>	<p>Moderate to deep upgrades to 44 Local Authority homes in various locations in Limerick City. 76% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include roof insulation, external wall insulation, cavity wall insulation, window upgrades, high efficiency boiler complete with heating controls and CFLs. The measures include roof insulation, cavity wall insulation, the installation of condensing boilers with fully integrated heating control upgrade with remote access and the removal of solid fuel back boilers and the installation of room heating stoves. Donegal County Council	<p>Deep upgrades to 33 mixed ownership homes in Inishowen and Glenties electoral areas in Donegal. 91% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, pumped cavity wall insulation, solar panels, windows and doors, new boilers and heating Controls, CFLs and chimney dampers. Donegal County Council and Retrofit Energy Ireland are the partners in this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 410,123.00 Grant Approved: € 271,581.00</p>
Clar ICH Warmer Homes	<p>Moderate and deep upgrades to 31 mixed ownership homes in Erris, County Mayo. 85% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include roof Insulation, wall insulation, heating system installation, including Condensing oil Boilers & Heating Controls, windows & doors upgrades and energy efficient lighting. Clar ICH, Mayo County Council and Mayo Energy Agency Limited are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 400,860.00 Grant Approved: € 294,665.00</p>

<p>Monaghan Area Scheme</p>	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 24 mixed ownership homes in Clones, Co. Monaghan. 92% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, cavity wall insulation; upgrade existing oil boilers to condensing oil boilers with heating controls and CFLs. Retrofit Energy Ireland, Monaghan County Council and Camcas Monaghan are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 137,870.00 Grant Approved: € 87,978.20</p>
<p>Wexford Town Area Scheme</p>	<p>Deep energy upgrades to 115 mixed ownership homes in Wexford town. 78% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include roof insulation, cavity wall insulation, window and door replacement, high efficiency boiler with heating controls, heating controls only upgrade, solar thermal and CFLs. <p>Dublin City Area Scheme</p>	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 82 mixed ownership homes in Dublin City area. 66% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, cavity wall insulation, high efficiency boiler with heating controls and CFLs. Dublin County Council and Retrofit Energy Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 322,860.00 Grant Approved: € 208,868.50</p>

<p>Navan Area Scheme</p>	<p>Moderate to deep energy upgrades of 38 mixed ownership homes in Navan, Co. Meath. 79% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, external wall insulation, cavity wall insulation, high efficiency boiler with heating controls and CFLs. Meath County Council and Retrofit Energy Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 244,610.00 Grant Approved: € 158,426.20</p>
<p>Birr Area Based Project</p>	<p>Deep energy upgrades to 41 mixed ownership homes in Birr, Co. Offaly. 90% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include roof insulation, cavity wall insulation, window replacement, external door replacement, boiler installation with fully integrated heating control upgrade, solid fuel room heater installation and CFL's. Roscommon Leader Partnership, Birr Town Council and Electric Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 167,742.74 Grant Approved: € 98,968.00</p>
<p>Better Energy Warmer Homes, Area Scheme in County Clare</p>	<p>Shallow energy upgrades to 188 Local Authority homes in various areas in County Clare. 82% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include ceiling level attic insulation, cavity wall insulation, CFLs and carbon monoxide alarm This project will also provide education to occupants on ventilation, carbon monoxide, condensation and dampness. Kingspan Energy, Clare County Council and Electric Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 194,313.49 Grant Approved: € 128,130.31</p>

Cork City Council	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 59 Local Authority homes across Cork City. 70% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include installation of gas boilers, zoned controls, attic and cavity wall insulation and CFLs. Cork City Council, a Community Based Organisation and Electric Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 562,466.00 Grant Approved: € 300,000.00</p>
Arann Islands	<p>Deep energy upgrades of 54 privately owned homes on Inis Mor and Inis Oirr. This project represents an excellent area based approach to upgrading homes out of range of most commercial service providers. 75% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include cavity wall insulation, attic insulation, internal and external insulation, stoves, oil fired boilers (convertible to biofuel), windows, doors, solar panels and energy advice. Aran Islands Energy Co-Op, a community based organisation, and Retrofit Energy Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 560,747.00 Grant Approved: € 473,859.00</p>

<p>New Ross Town Council</p>	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 35 Local Authority homes in four housing estates in New Ross, Co. Wexford which are occupied by old age pensioners. 94% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include high efficiency oil boiler with zoned heating controls, cavity wall insulation, loft insulation, new front doors and CFLs. Wexford Local Development, New Ross Town Council, NCE Insulation and Electric Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 232,255.05 Grant Approved: € 102,763.81</p>
<p>Athlone Area Based Project</p>	<p>Deep energy upgrades to 27 mixed ownerships homes in Athlone, Co. Roscommon. 78% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include cavity wall insulation, CFL's, room stove, roof insulation, windows and doors replacement and gas boiler & heating controls. Roscommon Leader Partnership, Athlone Town Council and Electric Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 178,094.54 Grant Approved: € 135,351.85</p>

Cavan Town	<p>Deep energy upgrades to 20 mixed ownership homes in Ard Na Greine and St Martins Estate in Cavan Town. 70% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include attic insulation, pumped cavity wall insulation, install new oil condensing boilers and full heating control pack including oil tanks as houses were heated by means of back boiler only, install new oil condensing boilers and full heating controls, new radiators, cylinders, oil tanks and bases as some houses did not have any central heating at all, upgrade existing oil boilers to condensing oil boilers with heating controls, windows and CFLs. Cavan County Council ,Camcas Cavan and Retrofit Energy Ireland are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 150,717.00 Grant Approved: € 92,582.20</p>
Tipperary Local Authorities	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 191 mixed ownership homes in various locations in Tipperary. 76% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include cavity wall, attic and external insulation, stoves, CFLs and energy advice. Stoves will be designed to use locally sourced sustainable wood logs. Each homeowner will receive 50kgs of wood and information on use/sourcing fuel. Homeowners will receive a 45 minute consultation from the BER assessors on how to reduce their energy use. Partnership includes 7 Local Authorities/Town Councils, Private Contractors, Tipperary Energy Agency and Airtricity</p> <p>Total Project: € 751,490.00 Grant Approved: € 500,000.00</p>

<p>Warmer Area Scheme Ballinasloe Co. Galway</p>	<p>Shallow to Moderate energy upgrades to 84 Local Authority homes in Ballinasloe, Co. Galway. 74% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include ceiling level attic insulation, wall Insulation, CFLs and carbon monoxide alarms. Kingspan Energy, Ballinasloe Town Council, Airtricity and Tipperary Energy Agency are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 111,395.00 Grant Approved: € 77,590.00</p>
<p>Secure & Fix It Enterprises Ltd t/a NCE Insulation</p>	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 21 mixed ownership homes in Oldcastle, Co. Meath. 90% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include roof insulation, cavity wall insulation, installation of condensing boilers with fully integrated heating controls, removal of solid fuel back boilers and the installation of room heating stoves. Oil Pay as You Go technology will also be installed in the homes to assist homeowners with the budget management and use monitoring of their heating oil requirements. <p>Warmer Homes Scheme Ennis Town</p>	<p>Shallow energy upgrades to 59 Local Authority homes in Ennis Town, Co. Clare. 88% of the homes are energy poor. <p>Southhill Development Co-op Ltd</p>	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 67 mixed ownership homes in various location in County Limerick. 70% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include cavity wall insulation external insulation, attic insulation, gas boiler & heating controls as required and CFLs. <p>Mountbolus Area Scheme</p>	<p>Shallow energy upgrades to 12 Local Authority homes in Glenn Ard, Mountbolus, Co. Offaly. 75% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include ceiling level attic insulation, cavity wall insulation, CFLs and carbon monoxide alarms. Education will be provided to occupants on ventilation, carbon monoxide, condensation, dampness, comfort and energy saving tips. Kingspan Energy and Mid Offaly Housing Association are partners on this project.</p> <p>Total Project: € 14,330.00 Grant Approved: € 9,830.00</p>
<p>Tipperary Local Authorities Project No 2</p>	<p>Moderate energy upgrades to 227 mixed ownership homes in various locations in Tipperary. 68% of the homes are energy poor. The measures include cavity wall, attic and external insulation, stoves, CFLs and energy advice. Stoves will be designed to use locally sourced sustainable wood logs. Each homeowner will receive 50kgs of wood and information on use/sourcing fuel. Homeowners will receive a 45min consultation from the BER assessors on how to reduce their energy use. Partnership includes 7 Local Authorities/Town Councils, Private Contractors, Tipperary Energy Agency and Airtricity</p> <p>Total Project: € 750,091.00 Grant Approved: € 509,495.00</p>
