



## **Electrical Safety Notice to the Homeowner**

Please read the following carefully and acknowledge your understanding by signing your name in the space provided

On inspection of the existing electrical installation, e.g. mains tails, distribution boards and earthing and bonding, being utilized by the circuits or a new installation, particularly installation of heating systems, controls, monitoring and lighting, the electrical installation was found not to be in accordance with I.S. 10101 National Rules for Electrical Installations.

SEAI recommend that the electrical installation be inspected by a Registered Electrical Contractor (REC).
